



## BRENNAN BEAR ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Brennan Bear Athletic Booster Club will award up to five scholarships to deserving student-athletes who plan to attend an accredited college, community college, trade or technical school as a full-time (12 or more credit hours per semester) student in the fall of 2023.

Up to \$5,000 in scholarships will be awarded to the winners. These scholarships are intended to award applicants for their participation in Brennan High School sports and their support of the Brennan Bear Athletic Booster Club. Applications will be judged without knowing the identity of the applicant. No parents, relatives, or guardians of seniors will be on the selection committee.

The money will be made payable directly to the chosen school in one complete installment at the beginning of the school year. The applicant will be ineligible to receive the scholarship if they have accepted a "full ride" (tuition, room and board) from their chosen school. In this case, they will be recognized as a winner, but the money will be awarded.

### Eligibility Criteria

- Athlete must have an overall GPA of 85 or higher through the end of the first semester senior year, and be a graduating senior planning to attend an accredited post-secondary school.
- Athlete must have participated in at least one UIL-sanctioned varsity sport at Brennan during their senior year, and athletics for at least 2 years in high school.
- Athlete/Parent/Guardian must be a member of BABC during the current school year.
- Athlete and Parents must have at least 5 volunteer hours each (10 total) with BBABC activities during the current year prior to submitting application.

### Selection Criteria

- Athletics: 36%
  - Participation in BHS UIL sanctioned Varsity sport(s), 5 pts/season for Varsity, 2pts/season for sub-varsity
  - Individual Athletic Awards/Honors received
  - Letter of Recommendation from a Coach (cannot be a family member)
- BBABC Participation: 31%
  - Number of combined parent and student volunteer hours with BBABC the past year (max 25 each/50 total)
  - Booster Club Membership (5pts/yr)
- Academics: 33%
  - Grades
  - Essay, 500 words, prompt in application
  - Letter of Recommendation from a non-coach (cannot be a family member)

## To Apply

Applications will be available at <http://www.brennanboosters.com> at the start of the second semester. Prepare the following items and submit electronically by **midnight, April 9, 2023**. Late applications will not be accepted or considered. Forms and more information on electronic submission requirements must be downloaded from <http://www.brennanboosters.com>. All submissions will be online only. Selections will be made by May 15, 2022 and announced by the end of May.

- Completed and signed application
- Essay (500 words or less)
- Letter of Recommendation from a coach that coached you in a sport (cannot be a family member)
- Letter of Recommendation from a non-coach (cannot be a family member)
- Log sheet of athlete's BABC volunteer hours
- Log sheet of parent/guardian's BABC volunteer hours
- Copy of transcript
- Extenuating Circumstances to consider (optional, 250 words or less; e.g. military PCS, moved during high school, previous booster club experience, loss of family member, financial situation, etc)

Scholarship application must be complete and correct or applicant will be disqualified.
